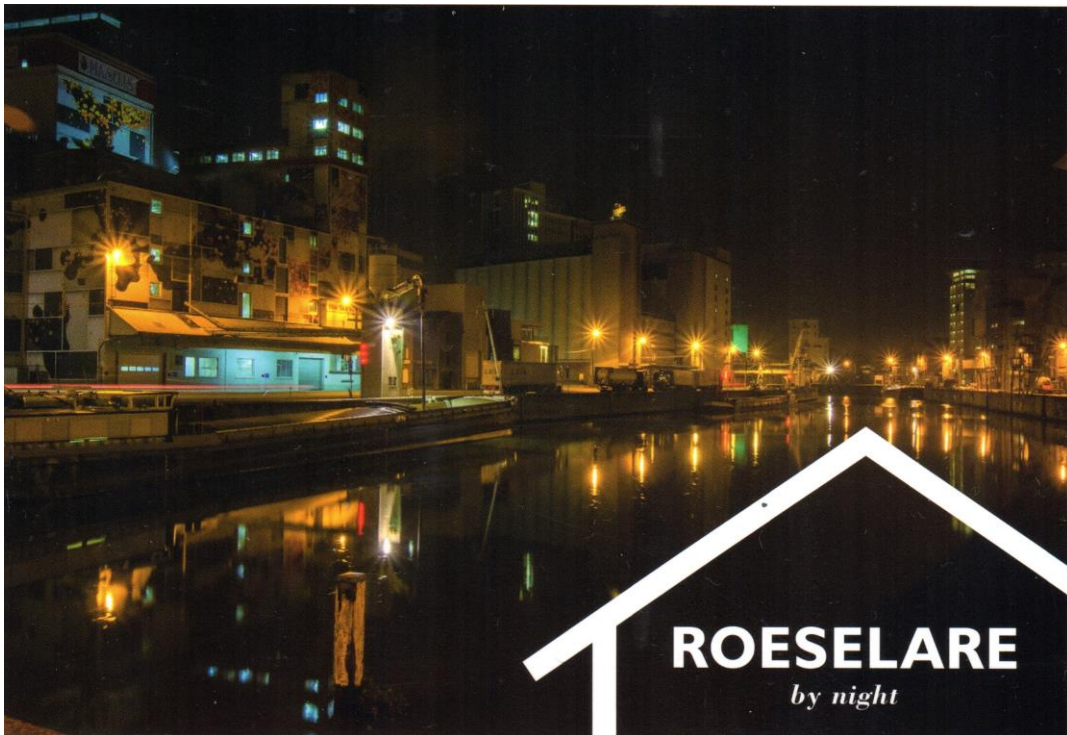
**ACCORDING TO TRIP ADVISOR:**
